Handicap cup rules

The following rules shall apply to both handicap singles and handicap doubles cup matches

Competitions.

- 1 Matches shall be played under ETTA rules and the winners of each match shall go through to the next round.
- 2 Handicap cup teams shall consist of three players. Players may play up or down within their club but must remain in the same team for the duration of the handicap cup competition.
- 3
 - a) Each player (or doubles combination) shall play a set of three games against each of the opposing team, (or doubles combination), starting at their adjusted handicap and playing to 21. There will be no deuce scores so a game could finish 21 - 20. At the end of each game the players' scores shall be recorded on the score-card. Service will change in multiples of 5 points.
 - b) One point shall be awarded for each set won and zero points for every lost set.
 - c) In the doubles competition the handicap of the partnership shall be found by taking the "middle letter" between the individuals' handicaps. If there is no exact middle then the letter to the left of middle shall be used.
- 4 The winning team shall be the first team to score five points.
- 5 The order of play and rules relating to play, conditions etc. shall be the same as the current league rules. The order of play for the doubles combinations shall be as for the knockout doubles cup competition.

- 6
 - a) League matches shall take precedence over cup games. All cup matches shall be played in the designated week or by the designated closing date of that round. If the matches are not played or conceded by the designated date then both teams shall be excluded from the next round unless agreed differently by the Fixture Secretary.
 - b) The home team is initially responsible for arranging the game but common sense should prevail with both team secretaries contacting each other as soon as possible after the previous round.
 - c) The Fixture Secretary must agree to a postponement.
 - d) If there is any dispute the Fixture Secretary will fix a date (and a venue) for the match to be played with the home team being responsible for hall hire and other costs involved.
- 7 Any player transferred from another team shall not have previously played in the competition.
- 8 Any dispute or complaint shall be addressed to the Fixture Secretary within 72 hours of the match being played or after the designated closing day by telephone and then confirmed in writing to the Officer. No disputes or complaints will be considered after that time.
- 9 The Fixture Secretary will then consider any appeals or disputes and refer them to a hearing to be made up of members of the Executive Committee who are not directly involved with the dispute and are not members of teams or associated teams referred to in the dispute or complaint. The decision of the panel shall be final.
- 10 All other rules shall be as specified in the current league rules and any queries raised which are not in the competition or league rules shall be decided by the Executive Committee after first addressing the problem via the Fixture Secretary.

Handicap Grid

Example: Chris Johnson (on an M handicap) is at home to Rod Hill (on a Q handicap). Find the square in the grid where the M row meets the Q column. The result is 6 therefore Chris starts on 0 and Rod starts on 6.

In a doubles match you would take the average letter for each pairing (rounding up if necessary). For example, if Chris and Rod were a doubles pair their doubles handicap would be O.

Any registered player having played 2 or fewer league matches can play on an "A" handicap. After playing 3 matches an adjusted handicap can be obtained. In this circumstance, call the Fixture Secretary at least 5 days before the match is to be played.
